Tide To Town will provide activity-friendly routes to everyday destinations throughout Savannah, with the goal of expanding to all of Chatham County and integrating with the East Coast Greenway. After many years of planning, the first segment of Tide To Town — the Truman Park Linear Trail — is now open!


